President's message

These are "interesting times". For the last six months it appeared that the new federal Liberal leader

was poised to call a spring election. Indeed, there is a very good chance that he still will.

As the sponsorship scandal continues to unfold, reporters are looking more closely at the Prime Minister's former dealings. It now appears that not only was he part and parcel of the sponsorship mess, but he has a large number of even uglier skeletons in his closet.

Will he go ahead and call an election in the next month, before the new Conservative party has time to organize, and before more details of his involvement in questionable dealings come to light? Or will he hold off until the fall, hoping the whole thing will blow over and be forgotten?

Whatever happens, the federal Liberals no longer are seen as the unbeatable force they were just two months ago. Now that Canada has two right wing parties, the NDP is the only party that can appeal to the centre and centre-left voters in the country. We can, and will, make large gains in the upcoming election. How large will depend on the work we do between now and the election.

We have significant challenges in Pickering-Scarborough East, including the political and geographic divide at the Rouge River. We will have to adopt organizing tactics from other multi-centre ridings. With the new federal funding formula, we have to go after every NDP vote we can get.

Our goal in this election is to achieve at least a second place finish. Even winning is not out of reach if we work hard enough.


New Web Sites

The www.scarborougheastndp.org URI also still takes you directly to the Scarborough East provincial riding site.


